Staying safe in the backcountry begins with recognizing unstable conditions and being able to perform a backcountry rescue. PAC and IDPR classes are geared towards teaching snowmobilers the basics of traveling safely in avalanche terrain. Our classes will provide you with the tools to make informed decisions and how to utilize local avalanche forecasts wherever you ride.

All field class participants must provide : their own sled (no two up riders), an avalanche beacon, avalanche probe and shovel. Warm clothes and lunches or snacks are a good idea as there will be some standing around.
